What Does That Mean?

Completing an intensive treatment program for substance use disorder may result in receiving time off of the end of your sentence, which we call: "Program Good Time Credit (PGTC)".

PGTC will be determined by the length of the program:

- 28 days – 59 days = 30 days of PGTC.
- 60 days – 90 days = 60 days of PGTC.
- 91 days – 180 days = 90 days of PGTC.

Successful completion is required

PGTC from Approved Providers became available after 8/1/2020. If you've completed an intensive program at an approved provider since 8/1/20, provide proof to your DOC staff.
